

## Investigation of Acute Non-viral Hepatitis Illnesses – "Real Water" Brand Alkaline Water (March 2021) | FDA

## Do not drink, cook with, sell, or serve "Real Water" alkaline water

The FDA, along with the CDC and the Southern Nevada Health District, is investigating a number of reports of acute non-viral hepatitis in the state of Nevada associated with "Real Water" brand alkaline water.

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Given a lack of cooperation by the firm, FDA investigators have been unable to complete investigations at the "Real Water" Inc. facilities in Henderson, NV and Mesa, AZ and have not been provided with requested records.
