

- 1. Vaccinated people should wear masks indoors (1).
- 2. Delta is being transmitted fairly well by vaccinated and infected people.
- 3. Case and Hospitalization rates in areas with low vaccination rates are going up, as are deaths.
- 4. Fifty-six healthcare organizations (AMA, ANA...) have supported vaccine mandates for healthcare workers (2).
- 5. Vaccines still prevent severe disease.
- 6. We have at least one local facility with 30-40 cases,proving that even the vaccinated can transmit.
- 7. The vaccine dramatically reduces the severity of illness.
- 8. Vaccines are safe and effective at preventing severe illness.
