COVID-19 Emergency Rule Wind-down Notice

Emergency rules related to COVID-19 and adopted in response to [Executive Order D 2020-038](#) (which has been amended and extended several times) are expected to wind-down over the next month. **Please note - Temporary Nurse Aide certifications are valid until the expiration date listed on the temporary license, but no longer than June 30, 2023. Employers should be mindful of the impact of the reinstatement of federal requirements based on the anticipated May 11, 2023 end of the COVID-19 national emergency and public health emergency declarations.**

An official date for the termination of these rules has not been set, however because we anticipate the emergency programs will be ending in the next month, the Division of Professions and Occupations is providing the following information to affected occupations and facilities to allow ample time to prepare for the changes.

The following programs are included in the wind-down:

Temporary licenses. The termination of the provision means no further temporary licenses will be granted on or after the official termination date. Those holding a current temporary license may work until the expiration date listed on the temporary license.

- Nursing
- Temporary licenses for professional or practical nurses holding an active, unrestricted license in good standing in a non-compact state
- Medical
 - Temporary licenses for Foreign Medical Graduates
