- Patients with cataracts, AMD, or glaucoma had 25% to 38% higher adjusted risks vs controls
- A <u>2014 CDC survey</u> of adults ages 65 and up found that 46.7% of those with severe vision loss reported a fall within the last year versus 27.7% of those without severe vision loss.
- In 2005, <u>a study of 537 older patients</u> with hip fractures in Scotland found that 46% had significant visual impairment, in almost half of cases due to untreated cataracts.
