Antimicrobial stewardship in long-term care (LTC) settings is critical to improving patient outcomes, reducing antibiotic resistance, and minimizing adverse events such as *C. difficile* infection. This quarterly series will provide a discussion forum for pharmacists, prescribers, medical directors, nurses, and infection preventionists in LTC facilities to promote appropriate antibiotic use. Format and Audience

-Frequency: Quarterly (four sessions per year)

-Format: 60-minute live virtual sessions via zoom

-Audience: LTC pharmacists, prescribers, medical directors, infection preventionists, and nurses involved in antimicrobial stewardship

-Structure: Each session will include a brief introductory presentation with updates, prepared discussion questions, with most time allotted for open discussion
